
Curling I/O

The Granite is moving to online registration using curling i/o. Everyone must register for curling individually online through curling i/o. https://clubs.curling.io/en/clubs/467-granite-curling-club

Click "Registration" to get you to the leagues. Add your league(s) to your cart. If you don't already have a profile in Curling I/O you'll need to set one up.

The 5th, 6th, etc. person needs to check the "5th player" check box in curling i/o.

Once registered, you MUST click 'submit' at the end of registration for it to be completed. To pay, please send an e-transfer to the Granite email address or mail a cheque to the club, payable to the Granite Curling Club: 1 Granite Way, Winnipeg, R3COY9. Payment can also be made at the Granite office using visa, mastercard or a debit card.
